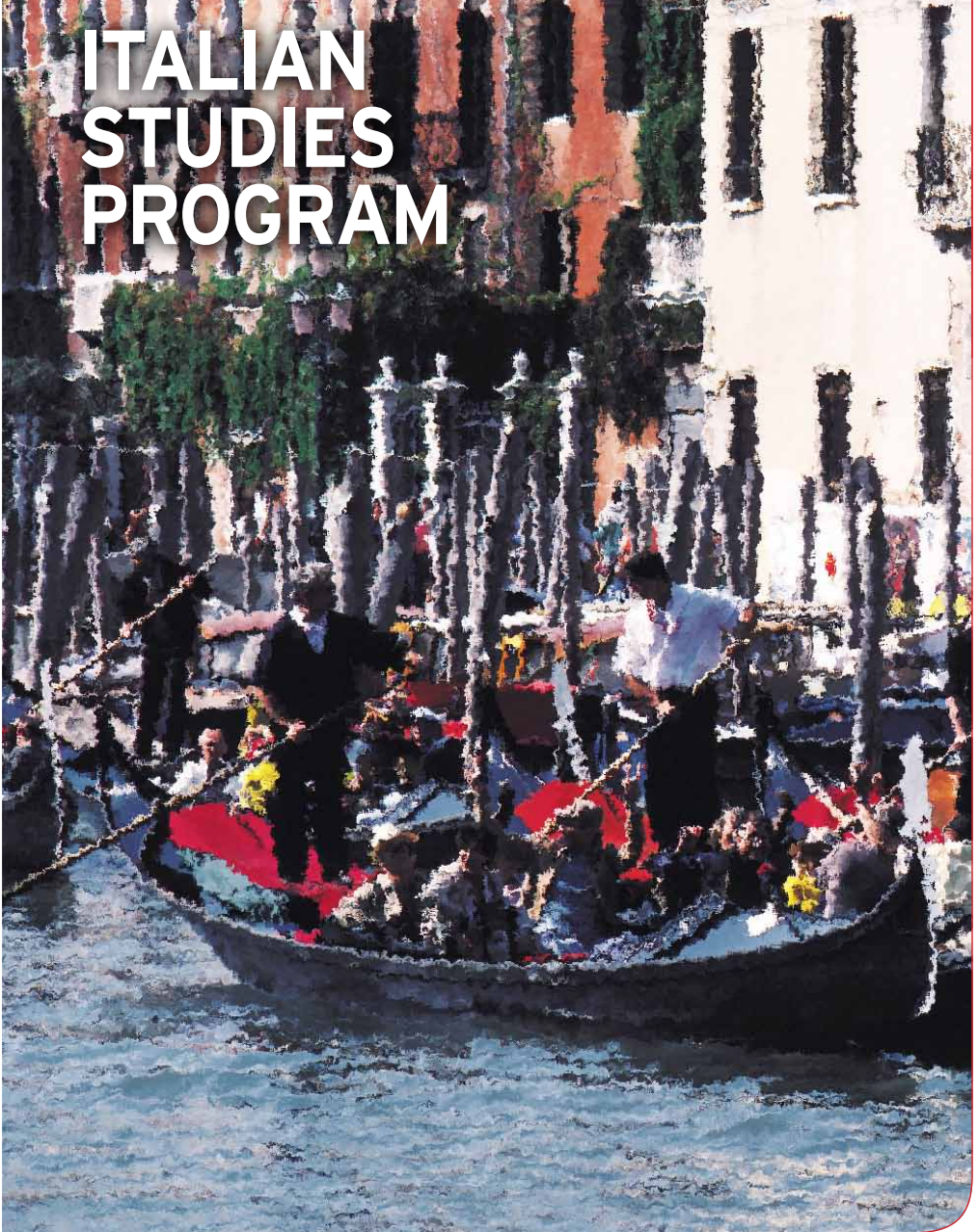

Undergraduate Degree Programs

Italian Language, Literature & Linguistics

This degree provides a full range of courses in the areas of language, literature and linguistics, most of which are taught in Italian.

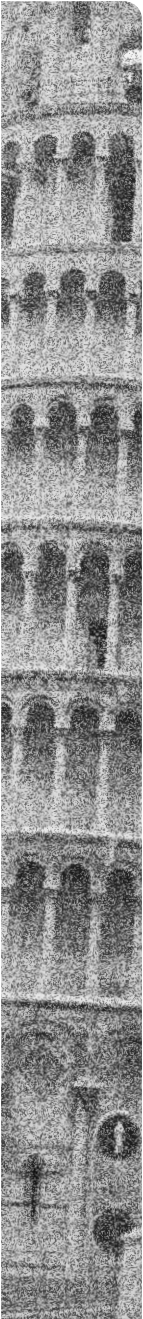
iBA Italian Studies has similar content, but includes courses taught only at one of our partner universities in Italy.

Italian Culture

Offered in English, the core requirements of this degree are three culture courses enhanced with electives chosen from our literature and culture courses, as well as from courses with significant Italian content taught by other departments.

Each of these three options consists of core courses taught by our faculty.

A **Certificate of Language Proficiency** in Italian is a great complement to a degree in another discipline, and is available to any York student not enrolled as a major or minor in Italian Studies. To accommodate all interested students, three levels of proficiency in the Italian language are offered as certificates: beginner, intermediate and advanced.



History, Beauty & Learning: Summer Studies in Italy

One of the most exciting features of the Italian Studies Program is the opportunity for students to enrich their studies by taking courses in Florence, Rome or Bologna as part of a summer studies program in Italy.

Especially designed for students interested in accelerating their abilities in Italian Studies through immersion and/or simply fast-tracking credits, these courses are suitable for majors, non-majors and those pursuing a Certificate of Proficiency in Italian. Whether incorporated into personal summertime travel plans or specifically integrated into a program of study, these courses afford the opportunity for students to gain a deeper understanding of the cultural, literary and scientific achievements of Italy. Participants have found these courses to be a transforming experience, enriching their knowledge through an intense but thoroughly enjoyable experience of Italy.



Resource-Rich Student Opportunities

- The Federazione Canadese Italiana (FCI), our award-winning student association, is dedicated to promoting and sustaining Italian culture and language through social and cultural activities, both at the university and in the surrounding community.
- Ital-Theatre @ York is a student theatre troupe founded to promote Italian language and culture at York and in the community. The theatre workshop has great pedagogical value for our students and also enables them to research the many facets of Italian theatre as a genre. The troupe annually performs an Italian play.
